Maintain trust in the profession

Teachers shall:

- Base their association with students on mutual respect;
- Work in a collaborative manner with colleagues;
- Maintain a good relationship with parents of students;
- Act with honesty, integrity and fairness;
- Be co-operative to the need for confidentiality wherever it requires;
- Maintain the quality of the professional practice;
- Impart knowledge in a way that engage and motivate the students to develop a perspective for lifelong learning.

Maintain a positive teacher-student relationship

Teachers shall:

- Maintain a positive relationship with students while in the college and out of the college, avoid inappropriate communication using any form of media with students;
- Behave in a way that keeps their unique position of trust and status as role models to the students;
- Follow College policies and guidelines as directed by authorities;
- Act with an inspiring and positive attitude at all times;
- Respect the academic freedom of students to learn, explore and challenge the ideas that the teacher shares.

Respect the Uniqueness and Diversity of students

Teachers shall:

- Respect the diversity of students;
- Practice equality irrespective of gender, race, caste, religion, class, appearance, age or ability.

Work in a Collaborative Manner with Colleagues and Parents of students

Teachers shall:

- Collaborate with colleagues in the highest standards of professional courtesy;
- Not make any public statements which bring the profession into disrepute;
- Work with parents of students with due respect;
- Co-operate and extend all support to keep the campus drug-free;
- Be supportive while dealing with public.

Act with Honesty and Integrity

Teachers shall:

- Conduct assessments with integrity and in compliance with official directives;
- Represent themselves honestly;
- Be always aware of their position as a mentor and influencer to all students.

Keep their Professional Knowledge and Practice Up to Date

Teachers shall:

- Maintain high standards in imparting knowledge, classroom management and assessments;
- Always keep their professional knowledge updated;
- Be open to constructive feedbacks from students or their parents regarding the teaching practices followed.
